SUGGESTED ANSWER

I must confess from the outset that I am one of those people who talk to themselves while walking in the street. This would mean, in fact, that I shelter/carry at least one more person within myself. And the problem is not whether this is good or bad, but whether this is good or bad manners to talk to yourself/ oneself. This comes top of the list in a series of indecent/ improper acts, together with sneezing and yawning, otherwise perfectly normal gestures.
